In November 2015, England-Thims & Miller conducted a [Transit Study](#) to determine public transportation needs and opportunities, and to explore and recommend transit options for Nassau County, Florida. Subsequently, the Transit Committee was created in February 2016 to discuss the County's need for public transportation, identify solutions, and offer a recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners.
