Pursuant to Nassau County Ordinance 2004-58, Section 4:) No dog trainer shall train any dog to be used as a companion pet dog, guard or sentry dog without possessing a valid permit. This section shall not apply to the city/county government or any of its agencies. The application for any dog training permit shall state the name and address of the trainer, location of the facility, and the maximum number of dogs to be housed at the training facility. Any dog trainer who works on any private or public property is also required to have a permit.

Annual permits shall be issued by animal control upon payment of \$50. The permitting period shall begin on October 1 and shall run for one (1) year. Renewal applications for permits shall be made thirty (30) days prior to, or thirty (30) days after, October 1. Application for a permit to establish a new commercial animal establishment under the provisions of this ordinance [article] may be made at any time. A late fee of twenty (20) percent of the permit amount will be assessed for applications not received within thirty (30) days of the date due for renewal.

The county may revoke any permit if the person holding the permit refuses or fails to comply with this ordinance [article], the regulations promulgated by the county, or any law governing the protection and keeping of animals.

It shall be a condition of the issuance of any renewal permit that the county shall be permitted to inspect all animals and the premises where animals are kept at any reasonable time and shall, if permission for such inspection is refused, revoke the permit of the refusing owner.

If the applicant has withheld or falsified any information on the application, the county shall refuse to issue a permit. No person who has been convicted of cruelty to animals shall be issued a permit to operate a commercial animal establishment.

Any person having been denied a permit may not reapply for a period of thirty (30) days. Each reapplication shall be accompanied by a fifty dollar (\$50.00) fee.
