

Contractor's license requirements for examination eligibility

General Contractor- Verified minimum 5 years' experience in a supervisor capacity under a general contractor, or have been a licensed building contractor for one year or a residential building contractor for 2 years or shall have the education and experience equivalent thereto as defined in the ordinance.

Building Contractor- Verified minimum 4 years' experience in a supervisory capacity under a general contractor or have been a licensed residential building contractor for not less than 1 year.

Residential Contractor- Verified minimum 5 years' experience in a supervisory capacity under a general building or residential contractor or education equivalent as defined in the ordinance.

Plumbing Contractor- Verified minimum 5 years' experience, 2 as a journeyman in a supervisory capacity, with educational equivalency not to exceed 2 years total in responsible charge of work.

Electrical Contractor- Verified minimum 5 years' experience with 2 years as a journeyman in a supervisory capacity with educational equivalency not to exceed 2 years total.

HARV Contractor- Verified minimum 5 years' experience in a supervisory capacity or educational equivalency not to exceed 2 years total to perform HARV work.

Roofing-Re-Roofing contractors- Verified minimum 5 years' experience in a supervisory capacity or educational equivalency not to exceed 2 years total of roofing or reroofing work.

Swimming Pool contractor- Verified minimum 5 years' experience in a supervisory capacity or educational equivalency not to exceed 2 years total pool construction experience.

Swimming Pool maintenance and repair contractor- Verified minimum 5 years' experience in a supervisory capacity or educational equivalency not to exceed 2 years total of swimming pool maintenance experience.

Master Plumber- Verified minimum 2 years' experience as a journeymen under a licensed plumbing contractor.

Master Electrician- Verified minimum 2 years' experience as a journeyman under a licensed electrical contractor.

Journeyman electricians or Journeyman plumbers:

Graduation from a registered 2 year apprenticeship program, which includes 2 years of work experience; or

Completion of 2 years attendance in a registered apprenticeship program which includes 2 years of work experience under a county or state licensed electrical or plumbing contractor; or

Four years' practical work experience under the direct supervision of a state licensed or county certified plumbing or electrical contractor.

SPECIALITY CONTRACTORS

Verified minimum 2 years' experience with 1 year in a supervisory position specializing in one of the building or contracting trades or crafts.

Experience verification letter must be on company letterhead signed by the appropriate license holder and notarized. The verifying license holder may be asked to provide evidence of good standing from the State, County or City in which the license is issued.
