

ADA/504 Transition Plan

- (1) The County will make every effort to ensure that its facilities, programs, services, and activities are accessible to those with disabilities. The County encourages participation on its advisory committees, public involvement activities and all other programs, services and activities by the disabled community and disability service groups.

- (2) The County encourages the public to report any facility, program, service or activity that appears inaccessible to those who are disabled. Furthermore, the County will provide reasonable accommodation to all individuals who wish to participate in public involvement events or who require special assistance to access facilities, programs, services or activities. Because providing reasonable accommodation may require outside assistance, organization or resources, the County asks that requests be made at least ten (10) calendar days prior to the need for accommodation. Questions, concerns, comments or requests for accommodation should be made to the County's ADA/504 Coordinator.
