FY 19/20 Goals

FY 18/19 Accomplishments

- Responded to 10,123 calls for service in calendar year 2018.
- Placed Tanker 60 in service June 1, 2019. Vehicle purchased as Capital Improvement item.
- Added a brush truck to the northern part of the county at station 40 to provide off-road access to brush fires as well as assistance on major incidents. Vehicle purchased as Capital Improvement item.
- Received State of Florida EMS grant valued at \$29,467.30 for the purchase of improved EMS reporting software.
- Purchased 8-sets of ballistic vests and helmets valued at \$8,579.00, using state of Florida EMS grant funds, for use in active assailant events. These items are carried in our Battalion Chief vehicles in order to be available rapidly if needed.
- Purchased one (1) engine, one (1) rescue, and one (1) ladder as part of Fleet Replacement Program.
- Department hands-on orientation day with BOCC members June 28, 2019.
- Continue to maintain and improve community outreach programs.
- Continue to maintain strong relationships with NCSO and Emergency Management.

FY19/20 Goals

- Improve staffing levels on two (2) engines and our one (1) ladder raising each from current staffing of 2 to 3 to get us closer to meeting NFPA standards.
- Increase our ability to complete fire inspections more efficiently by employing a new fire inspector.
- Begin construction of Fire Station 71 at Heron Isles.
- Add an additional tanker to the west side at station 90 to provide a water source to that part of the county.
- Purchase battery powered extrication equipment for each engine company as a Capital Improvement item.
- Improve our public education ability by purchasing a fire extinguisher training system.
- Add a vehicle storage building to NCFR property to house our spare vehicles and other equipment in a secure area.
- Work with Three Rivers DRI to begin the process of building a fire station and procure apparatus as indicated by the developer agreement.
- Fill all positions as needed.
- Purchase one (1) engine and two (2) rescues as part of Fleet Replacement.
- Purchase one (1) tanker and one (1) brush truck, as part of the Capital Improvement Program.
