Accomplishments for FY 18/19

- Achieved a 97% Live Release Rate, maintaining our shelters “No Kill” status. We achieved this while seeing a significant increase in calls for service and animal intake.
- Acquired an additional Petco store to hold adoption events. This additional store will increase our adoptions as well as the donations we receive from the Petco Foundation.
- Sent some of our Animal Control Officers to school to obtain their Equine Cruelty Investigations certification, Canine & Feline Cruelty Investigations certification and Field Training Officer certification. We now have an ACO that is a Florida Animal Control Association Certified Euthanasia Instructor. We can now hold courses to certify other animal care workers in Florida who require this certification.
- Organized volunteer orientations with the help of one of our volunteers. This was helpful in recruiting more volunteers and having them all understand how the facility operates and how they can help while at the shelter.

Goals for FY 19/20

- Maintain NCAS’s “No Kill” status by having a live release rate of 90% or higher.
- Upgrade the departments computers and camera systems.
- Purchase tablet computers to replace the many forms that the public is required to fill out while at the shelter.
- Cover the remaining outdoor kennels that are not yet covered.
- Re epoxy the floors in the Outside Stray building
- Replace the Medical transport/ Adoption Event van.
