

**NASSAU COUNTY**  
**EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 21**  
**(Emergency Management – COVID-19)**

**WHEREAS**, the Governor issued Executive Order 20-123 that addressed vacation rentals;  
and

**WHEREAS**, the County issued Executives Orders 3, 4, 10, 12 and 13 requiring reporting of information to the Amelia Island Convention and Visitors Bureau (AICVB); and

**WHEREAS**, the Governor issued Executive Order 20-192 rescinding travel restrictions and reporting requirements for individuals traveling from the New York Tri-State Area (New York, New Jersey and Connecticut) and the State of Louisiana; and

**WHEREAS**, based upon the Governor’s Executive Order, the County Manager has determined that the requirements outlined in local Executive Order 10 should be modified and that the requirements outlined in local Executive Orders 3, 4, 12 and 13 are no longer necessary.

**NOW, THEREFORE, MICHAEL S. MULLIN**, as Nassau County Manager, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Local State of Emergency and County Emergency Management Plan and with the consent of the Emergency Management Director, promulgate the following Executive Order to take immediate effect:

1. Local Executive Order 10 is hereby amended to rescind Sections 2, 9 and 10.
2. Local Executive Order 3 is hereby rescinded.
3. Local Executive Order 4 is hereby rescinded.
4. Local Executive Order 12 is hereby rescinded.
5. Local Executive Order 13 is hereby rescinded.

6. All other provisions of local Executive Order 10 not in conflict with this Executive Order shall remain in effect.
